GENERAL RULES

Exam Rules

1. Students have to pass a 90-minute written exam (covering the entire program) at the end of the course. There will be no midterm exam.
2. The use of any electronic device such as cellphones/smartphones, tablets, smartwatches, laptops is strictly forbidden during the exam (it will be possible to use only a non-digital calculator).
3. Students must sign up online for the exam. Each student is personally responsible for signing up. It will be absolutely impossible to ask the course instructor to do it if the student fails to sign up before the deadline.
4. Students can withdraw during the written test at any time.
5. Exam grades range from 0 (zero) to 30+ (trenta e lode).
6. If the student fails (<18) or refuses to register the final exam, she or he can retake it in any scheduled call.
7. (info for II or III-year students) The exam is the same regardless of your enrollment year. Hence, all students must cover this year program. The detailed program is given by all topics covered in class and in the TA sessions.

Problem Sets and Bonus Points

- a. A total of 7 take-home problem sets will be assigned during the course.
- b. Solutions to the problem sets must be hand-written and must be handed in *personally* and *exactly* on the due date.
- c. The problem sets will be checked by the TA but will not be graded.
- d. (Under the conditions specified in point g) below) Two (2) bonus points will be assigned to every student who delivers on time 7 solutions to the 7 problem sets;
- e. (Under the conditions specified in point g) below) One (1) bonus point will be assigned to every student who delivers on time at least 6 solutions to the 7 problem sets;
- f. The bonus points will be added to those obtained in the written test to determine the grade of the final.
- g. The bonus points are **only valid in the summer session** and **only once**. Specifically:
 - a. If an eligible student shows up in the first call (primo appello), the bonus points will be automatically assigned to them (even if the student fails, refuses the grade or withdraws).
